Most drivers admit to dangerous driving behaviors

About 87 percent of drivers engaged in at least one risky behavior while behind the wheel within the past month, according to the latest research by the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety. In a recent news release about the study, the foundation said that these unsafe behaviors include driving while distracted, impaired, or drowsy; speeding; running red lights; or not wearing a seatbelt. Nearly 33,000 Americans died in car crashes in 2014.

"The vast majority of motorists believe they are more careful than others on the road, though most of them are not making safe decisions while behind the wheel," said Peter Kissinger, president and CEO of the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety. "We're asking every driver to make responsible decisions to make the roads safer for everyone."

In addition to driving habits, survey participants were asked about their personal experiences with vehicle accidents. It found that one in three drivers have had a friend or relative seriously injured or killed in a crash, and one in five has been involved in a crash that was serious enough for someone to go to the hospital.

The survey data are from a sample of 2,442 licensed drivers ages 16 and older who reported driving in the past 30 days. The AAA Foundation issued its first Traffic Safety Culture Index in 2008, and the latest report is online at www.AAAFoundation.org.

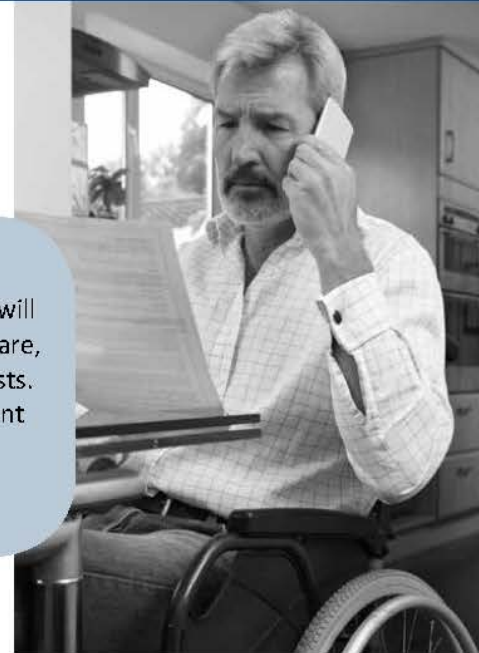
Collect now for future expenses

After a life-changing injury, you will want to take stock of past and current financial needs. An initial settlement offer that is close to this amount may seem tempting, but don't forget to calculate potential future expenses.

What are future costs?

If you were severely injured, there is a good chance that medical and other treatment bills will continue well into the future. Rehab, pharmaceuticals, medical equipment, in-home nursing care, assistive devices, and adaptive changes to a home or vehicle can all be calculated as future costs. In addition to the more obvious claims, people can also put a price on permanent disfigurement and loss of enjoyment, and a spouse and family members may be able to recover for loss of consortium (loss of intimacy and relationship due to accident).
